10 COMMANDMENTS FOR PARENTS

(Ten tips for making the home-school connection a little clearer)

- 1. Thou shalt have priorities- The first priority is family.

- 7. Thou shalt know who thy child's friends are: remember, kids act according to their friends.
- 8. Thou shalt allow thy child to suffer consequences: constantly bailing them out won't teach them anything.
- 9. Thou shalt recognize thy child's efforts: remember, children do want to please their parents.
- 10. Thou shalt be thy child's parent: they don't need another friend; they need parents.
